

Flying Your US Glider In Canada

The procedure to fly your "Experimental" glider in Canada is now called a "Validation of Foreign Flight Authority".¹

Please scan your Certificate of Registration and special Certificate of Airworthiness with the Letter stating the Operating Limitations. PDF format is preferred.

Then, there is a fee of CAD \$100 and you should be able to pay this with Visa or MC by phone at (800)305-2059. Note this receipt number in your package of scanned documents.

Send the documents and the following request to <u>AEGinternal-GEAinterne@tc.gc.ca</u> for processing.

Request permission to fly your American registered glider licensed in the "Experimental" category at the Canadian National Gliding Championships and mention the dates and location of the contest as well as weekends before, and after the contest.
